Part 1 Details Riders will stage in the church parking lot. After the briefing, Riders will stand Tall and Silent as the family arrives for the Rosary starting at 0930, and will continue to stand Tall and Silent as family and friends gather for the funeral service starting at 1000. At the start of the funeral service, flags in front of the church will be furled and returned to the support vehicle. Flags in the inurnment garden, adjacent to the church entrance, will remain in place. At the completion of the funeral service, Riders will stand a Flag Line at the inurnment site for the inurnment service. There will not be a separate briefing before the inurnment service. At the completion of the inurnment service, flags will be returned to the support truck, Riders debriefed and dismissed
